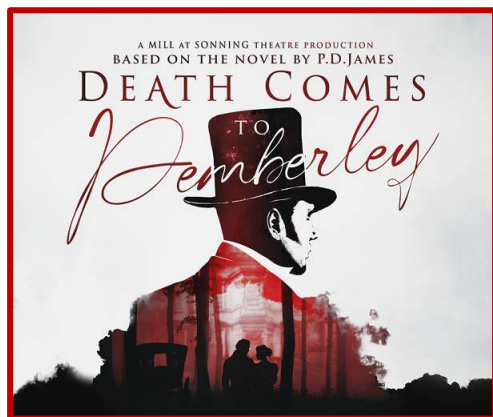


A thrilling murder mystery at The Mill at Sonning**DEATH COMES TO PEMBERLEY**
