

CHARTWELL

Our day begins with a visit to Chartwell in Kent, home to Sir Winston Churchill for over forty years. Churchill loved Chartwell, and lived here until his death in 1965. Here he was not only a politician and statesman but also a husband, father, writer, painter and garden planner.

The house - in which the rooms remain much as they were when he lived here, with pictures, books and personal mementoes. A special exhibition gives deeper insight into his life through 50 objects.

The Studio - houses the largest single collection of Winston Churchill's paintings.

The gardens - reflect Churchill's love of landscape and nature. They include the lakes he created, and Rose, Walled and Kitchen gardens. A truly fascinating and beautiful place.
